Club Reminders

As we begin a new year, your Board of Directors would like to remind you of a few important items... **PLEASE READ!**

Email:

To begin with, we ask that you take a look at your Email settings. Please mark LLYC as a safe sender, so that you don't miss any of our mailings! Some members have mentioned not receiving emails from LLYC, but then locate them in their "spam/junk" folders. So make sure we land in your IN box!

Name Tags/Badges:

Please note that all members and guests must wear their name tags/badges at all times while in the Clubhouse. Please double check to make sure your guests sign in at the door and make a guest name badge for themselves.

Key Club:

There is no longer any cash being kept in the register at the Bar. If you come in during Key

Club, note that you will either need to run your tab through Square (credit card) in order to pay, or have exact change with you.

Private Events:

If the Calendar is marked for a Private Event, or there is a sign at the door, members are not allowed to be in the Clubhouse (unless the renter has agreed to such). We have had some issues with members showing up at the Club during a Private Event. Unless you are an invited guest, please respect the rental and come back another time.

Isonas (Key Club) Access:

You do not need to be at the Clubhouse in order to set up your Isonas/Key Club access. This can be set up remotely with one of our Officers through the Isonas App on your mobile phone.

NOTE: If you get a new mobile phone, you must reinstall and reactivate the Isonas App. This is not transferable from one phone to another, as access is attained through your specific ID Device number.
