Raising the Bar

I would like to congratulate Christine Adams for rejoining our Bartender staff. She is licensed, experienced, with a sparkly personality. You may know her as the Business Manager for the Loch Lomond Marina, so if we need anything from the office, we always can reach out to her, especially with our busy season approaching.

I would like to give a warm welcome to Mary Wuerth, who this weekend will be doing her first "behind the bar" experience with us, to help keep the smile of our Club members and patrons. With that said, we would like to invite and encourage more members to become certified and join us, so we can have more staff, in other words, more days and hours open to our members. Members that are not certified and have an interest in bartending, please reach out to us, so we can guide you through the process to get your ABC ilcense, Etips license, as well as a Food Handlers license. I would like our bartenders to have the Food Handlers certification as well, so we can help Stella, who is often short staffed. Food handlers certification will give us more authority and confidence when we work in private events, that most of the time have food involved.

I would like to let our members know that we are waiting for our first order of "Ocean Jefferson". Ocean Jefferson is a special line of Bourbon Whisky whereby barrels are aged in tocean water for 8, 10, 12, 15 or more years, giving a distinct crisp special flavor. It is one of the top choices for American Sailors in the US, so don't be shy to ask our bartenders for it.

Lastly, I would like to share a recipe for a *Negroni,* a very popular, tasty drink that is one of my favorites:

NEGRONI:

Gin: London Dry is the traditional; I prefer a Citrus-forward from the new school or a Botanical flavor like Empress 1906.

Campari: a bitter orange Italian aperitif that gives the Negroni its big flavor and signature orange-red hue.

Vermouth: since there are only 3 ingredients, I like a slightly sweeter red vermouth to ensure all the right flavors shine through.

Orange peel: twist the peel over the glass before adding in order for the orange oils enhance the aroma of the cocktail.
