### **Important Notices**

Your Board of Directors would like you to be aware of some important updates recently made at the Club.

At our most recent Board Meeting on March 27, there were several topics of discussion and votes that effect the following areas:

**Sun Room and Smoking:** There have been a number of complaints from members and guests regarding residual second-hand smoke entering the Bar area from smokers in the Sun Room. Research had been done regarding the City of San Rafael's smoking ordinance back in 2018. It was determined that smoking was not permitted in our Sun Room. In addition to the ordinance, it has been discovered that the boards underneath the Sun Room, as well as the roof, are showing signs of wear and tear, and thus are becoming a hazard. For these reasons, the Board has passed a new House Rule to no longer allow smoking in the Sun Room. Those who wish to smoke, may step outside the front of the Club and must stay 20 feet away from the front door

(based on San Rafael City's ordinance).

This was not an easy decision to come to, as we know some of our members and guests enjoy smoking in the Sun Room. But for everyone's safety and enjoyment of the Club, this will be the new rule taking effect immediately. Signage will be added as soon as possible and shall not be removed.

Payments for No-Shows: Another item that was discussed was the area of our Evite system. Sadly, we have seen an increase in the number of members/guests replying Yes to an event via Evite, but then not showing up. This causes hardship for those planning the event as well as a loss of revenue. If you RSVP that you are coming, food, etc is purchased based on your attendance. We use the Evite system to determine how much food to purchase. When someone doesn't show up, that creates waste.

This negatively impacts the Club and its members financially. Thus, we ask that members please respect the RSVP system.

If you RSVP "yes" but find that you cannot make it, please change your RSVP on Evite at least 48 hours before the event. We know sometimes things come up and you may not be able to make it at the last minute. However. going forward, it will be necessary to invoice those no-shows for the cost of the event. We will continue to keep this notice on the Evites as a reminder.

**Drinking Behind the Bar:** Another area of concern that was brought to the Board's attention was Bartenders drinking while "on duty." Part of the issue is that bartenders may work for many areas without a break. The Board wants to work on this so that bartenders can step away for a bit, have a drink, etc, and then return to their duties. To this end, we need more members to step up and serve as bartenders. Remember that you do have to be certified by the State of California. However, the certification process is not difficult and we encourage members to take the short course in order to be able to help out at the bar.\*

After discussion, the Board passed a resolution that Bartenders may not consume alcohol while on duty.
